Russia Moscow /River Cruise/ST.,Petersburg 13 Days Tour

Day 1. Departure on a Lufthansa flight to Frankfurt.

Day 2. Connecting flight to St. Petersburg, arrival transfer to the hotel. Your hotel: Dostoevsky Hotel(3.5 *),superior room,

Day 3. St. Petersburg. One of Europe's most magnificent cities, often called "Venice of the North" experience the architecture, natural beauty and rich Culture of the city. St. Petersburg the former capital of Czarist Russia, was found by Peter the Great in 1703. tour drive along the famous Nevsky Prospect and view Peter and Paul's fortress and St. Isaac Cathedral Lunch at a downtown restaurant. Enjoy a canal cruise for a different view on the city. Transfer to the ship (B/L/D).

Day 4. St. Petersburg-Guided excursion to Pushkin situated 29km from Saint-Petersburg. Visit of the summer residence of the imperial family since the XVIIth century. Catherine's Palace and its beautiful gardens are masterpieces of Russian architecture. You will see the Amber Room. Lunch AT Podvorie Restaurant .5KM from Pushkin, you will visit the great palace of Pavlosk and its gardens. Dinner and folklore show at Nikolaevsky Palace.(B/L/D)

Day 5. St. Petersburg- Visit the priceless art collection presented at the famous Hermitage Museum, located at the Winter Palace. Lunch at a downtown restaurant. Guided excursion to Petrodvorets situated on the southern shore of the Gulf of Finland, 29km from the Saint Petersburg. Its parks occupy a territory of about 1000ha and stands on the edge of a steep slope descending to the sea. The Grand Cascade, which runs from the northern facade of the Grand Palace to the Marine Canal, comprises 64 different fountains and over 200 bronze statues, bas-reliefs, and other decorations. Return to ship for dinner and overnight

Day 6. Mandrogui-Free time in this touristic village, shashlik(barbecue)shore.(B/L/D)

Day 7. Kizhi Island. Awake this morning at the fairy tale Island of Kizhi, situated in the northern part of Lake Onega. Kizhi boasts a delightful open-air museum

and walking tour include the Church of Transfiguration, a truly outstanding masterpiece of wooden structure, a folklore concert is included. (B/L/D)

Day 8. Goritzi-Visit of St Cyril Monastery and museum of icons. (B/L/D)

Day 9. Yaroslave- City tour, local market (free time),inside visit of Church of St.Nicholas the Wonderworker, Church of St. Elijah the Prophet(outside),interactive tour of former Governor's House.(B/L/D)

Day 10. Uglich-Walking city tour with the visit to the territory of the Kremlin, Dmitry on the Blood Church, Transfiguration Cathedral.(B/L/D)

Day 11 Enjoy an orientation tour and view the city major highlights: Red Square, St. Basil's Cathedral with its colorful onion domes and the Kremlin. Visit Moscow's ornate Metro system. Meals on board. In the evening, famous Moscow circus performance. (B/L/D)

Day 12 Moscow- Visit of the Kremlin's grounds where you'll see the Czar's Cannon, the 200 ton Czar's Bell and the architecturally striking Cathedral. Lunch at a downtown restaurant. Leisure time for shopping if time permits.(B/L/D)

Day 13 Moscow-Transfer to airport. (B)
